Depression and other behavioral health problems are just that – health problems – not personal failures. And sometimes they need to be treated in a hospital setting with support from physicians, nurses, and other healthcare professionals.

MetroHealth's new facility includes 112 new beds for inpatient care for adolescents, adults and elders struggling with addiction and mental health issues. Hospital stays will be short term (7-10 days on average) while people are evaluated and stabilized.

Care doesn't end when the hospital stay is over. Each person's journey to wellness is different. Depending on individual needs, our specialists recommend a continuing care plan that consists of Partial Hospitalization (PHP), Intensive Outpatient (IOP), or Outpatient care.



The new MetroHealth Behavioral Health Center includes:

- Partial Hospitalization (PHP)
- Intensive Outpatient (IOP)
- Outpatient care
- Warm and welcoming lobby
- Family Consultation Room
- A variety of social spaces
- Dining area to encourage socialization
- Indoor Recreation Center with activities such as yoga, gaming, stretching and meditation
- Enclosed outdoor garden area
- 24/7 security

New admissions for adults begin October 9, 2022.

Coming in 2023:

- Dual Diagnosis Unit that will provide inpatient care for people who have a combination of mental illness and addiction.
- Adolescent Unit that will provide inpatient care to ages 13-17 years.
- Geropsychiatry Unit that will provide inpatient care to older adults ages 55+.
